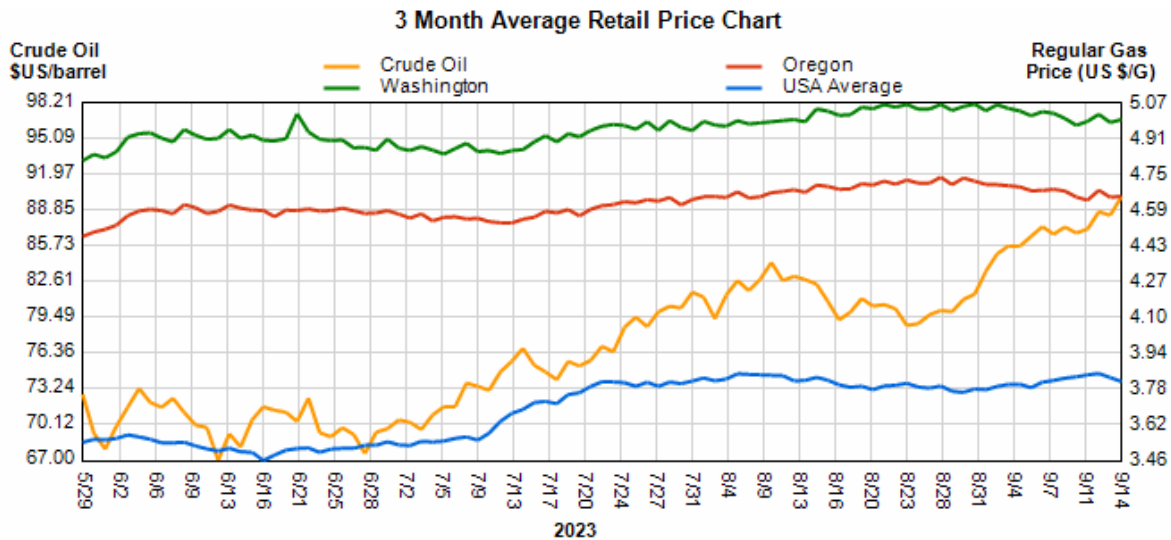

### **Fuel Market News:**

#### **Oregon**

##### **Supply Changes:**
